### MURTHA TO ATTEND STOREY SQUARE APPRECIATION EVENT

Uniontown, PA - U.S. Representative John P. Murtha (D-Johnstown) will attend an appreciation event in Downtown Uniontown's Storey Square Tuesday, August 22nd beginning at 8:30 a.m.

County Commissioner Joseph A. Hardy, III is hosting the event to recognize Murtha for the \$481,120 HUD/EDI grant Murtha secured to assist with ongoing revitalization efforts in the City of Uniontown.

The grant was managed by the Fayette County Redevelopment Authority and utilized to develop a canopy structure in the newly expanded Storey Square along with a new marquis for the State Theatre Center for the Arts, both located along East Main Street in Uniontown.

The event will also honor contractors who worked on the two projects. The canopy structure was designed by BCD Design Concepts of Pittsburgh and structurally by McMillen Engineering of Uniontown. The structure was then developed and fabricated by Allison Custom Fabrication of Allison. The fabric canopy was completed by Hibbs Awning of Uniontown.

The State Theatre Center for the Arts marquis was designed by Adomovich Design of Hopwood and structurally by the donated services of Fayette Engineering of Uniontown. The sign was then developed at MC Sign Company of Mentor, Ohio with donated assistance from Pierce Hardy Limited Partnership of Eighty Four.

Hardy along with Uniontown city officials including Mayor James Sileo, fellow County Commissioner Vincent A. Vicites, PA Senator Richard A. Kasunic (D-District 32) and PA Representative James E. Shaner (D-District 32) will also be on-hand at the event.
