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JOHNSTOWN, PA - Congressman John P. Murtha announced today at the annual Showcase for Commerce that Lockheed Martin Corporation has awarded JWF Industries their Electronic Systems Business Area STAR Supplier Award.

JWFI is the first metal fabrication supplier to Lockheed Martin's Owego, NY site to be awarded and is currently one of only 96 suppliers to be awarded this honor. Designed to recognize supplier excellence, the STAR award is granted to a limited number of Lockheed Martin top-performing suppliers who distinguish themselves by meeting some of the most strict performance criteria within the aerospace industry.

To join Lockheed's elite group of STAR suppliers, JWFI achieved 100 percent quality and 100 percent delivery for all product quality and delivery objectives over the course of a minimum of one year. Additionally, the Company met the established criteria for Lockheed Martin's Supplier Performance Evaluation metric within four categories comprised of quality, delivery, affordability and management/administration.

Murtha noted that JWF Industries has experienced significant growth over the past few years.

"JWFI has demonstrated that by achieving the highest percentage of quality and delivery from Lockheed Martin that they can compete with the best in the defense industry," Murtha said.

"The STAR award is really a tremendous honor. It recognizes the hard work, responsiveness and dedication of the men and women at JWF who support the work we do for Lockheed Martin," said Bill Polacek, CEO of JWF Industries. "JWF Industries will continue its relentless pursuit of the programs with Lockheed Martin, including the Joint Light Tactical Vehicle contract, which could mean long term employment for our families in the Johnstown region."

Lockheed Martin introduced the STAR Supplier Program award in 1999 with the dual objectives of developing stronger supply chain relationships and providing a recognition means for their top-performing suppliers. All Lockheed Martin STAR Suppliers are provided with increased visibility across the Lockheed Martin Corporation. This exposure results in increased opportunity for business and consideration for reduced oversight at the supplier level. Lockheed Martin and its customers likewise share benefits in higher supplier product quality, improved delivery performance and associated cost savings that result due to this valuable relationship.

JWF Industries operates six facilities, five in Johnstown, PA and one in Baltimore, MD. The company currently employs more than 500 people. In December 2006 Lockheed Martin named JWF Industries as a teammate in its bid to win the

contract for the U.S. Army's Joint Light Tactical Vehicle (JLTV) program. JLTV is intended to be the next generation in light armored wheeled tactical vehicles for the armed services.
