Murtha: Meadow Ridge Business Park Receives \$250,000 Grant

Washington D.C. - Congressman John P. Murtha, Chairman of the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Defense, announced today that the Meadow Ridge Business Park in Greene County has been awarded a \$250,000 grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC).

This funding will make improvements to the business park's access road along State Route 2009, including curbing, channelization, pavement markings, lighting, signage and landscaping.

"I'm pleased that this funding will make necessary improvements that will help Greene County continue to attract new businesses and jobs to our area," commented Murtha.

The Meadow Ridge Business Park is a designated Keystone Opportunity Zone location. This project will support the creation of approximately 250 new jobs and the retention of approximately 145 existing jobs. The project will be administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT).
