Murtha Announces Local Fire Department and EMS Grants

Washington D.C. - Congressman John P. Murtha announced today that the Department of Homeland Security has released Assistance to Firefighters Grants to 12th District volunteer fire departments and emergency medical service (EMS) organizations.

These competitive grants are provided to fire departments and nonaffiliated EMS organizations to enhance first responders' ability to protect the health and safety of the public and that of first-responder personnel. Since 2004, Assistance to Firefighters Grants has provided a total of almost \$2.2 billion to first-responder organizations to purchase response equipment, personal protective equipment, and vehicles.
