(JOHNSTOWN, PA) – Representatives from Congressman John P. Murtha's Office will host two seminars in the 12th Congressional District offering grant writing information and instruction for the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters grants.

These seminars are open to all Fire Departments, EMS organizations, state, boro, and township elected officials, within the 12th Congressional District, to help those who apply for the yearly Assistance to Firefighters grant. It is also a chance to ask questions and gain insight as to how the grant application process is conducted.
