A staffer also visits Lower Burrell Municipal Building, 2800 Bethel St., every Wednesday from 9 a.m. to noon. On the first and third Wednesdays of each month, he will be in the office of state Rep. Joseph Petrarca, 239 Longfellow St., Vandergrift.
