LOCKHEED MARTIN AWARDS \$1 MILLION VH-71 PRESIDENTIAL HELICOPTER SUBCONTRACT TO MTS TECHNOLOGIES

OWEGO, NY - Congressman John Murtha announced at the Showcase for Commerce today that Lockheed Martin [NYSE: LMT] has awarded MTS Technologies of Johnstown, PA, a \$1 million contract to provide information assurance and security systems engineering support for the VH-71 Presidential Helicopter program.

Work conducted under this contract will begin immediately and continue through March 2007.

"Lockheed's selection of MTS is a tribute to MTS' technical, engineering and management services expertise," Murtha said. "I'm delighted that local workers are involved in Lockheed's program to build the world's safest and most secure helicopter system."

The VH-71 is based on the US101 helicopter, the American variant of AgustaWestland's successful EH-101 multimission helicopter. AgustaWestlandBell, the U.S. principal subcontractor to Lockheed Martin, has responsibility for the air vehicle design, configuration management and support. More than 200 suppliers in 41 states support the VH-71 program.
